



Fun Facts about Pack 25



Pack 25 was formed in **May of 1938**, only eight years after BSA started the program. We have been continuously chartered ever since.

In our 2017-2018 programming year, our Cub Scouts (and sometimes siblings) hiked a total of approximately **138 miles**.

In our 2017-2018 programming year, we camped as families as well as Cub Scouts (with an adult) at Summer Camp. Our Family Camp nights in 2017-2018 totaled **82 nights** and our Summer Camp nights in 2018 totaled **54 nights**.

Our Cub Scouts served their community approximately **148 hours** in our 2017-2018 programming year. Their service included Earth Day Clean Up, placing flags on veteran graves at Canfield Village Cemetery, marching in the Canfield Memorial Day parade, and packing food at the Food Bank.

We presently have all ranks covered with leaders and **All Den Leaders EXCEPT ONE** are Position Specific Trained.

In 2018, we had 18 Cub Scouts who attended summer resident camp, and 12 Cub Scouts who attended Day Camp. Of our 34 currently active Cub Scouts, 28 attended some form of summer program, which is **82%** of our pack.

All three of our 2017-2018 Webelos Arrow of Light Scouts achieved Arrow of Light, the highest rank in Cub Scouting. In addition, **33 Scouts** achieved their rank who were with us during the 2017-2018 programming year.

All three (**100%**) of our 2017-2018 Webelos crossed over to Scouts BSA and all three are currently registered with a troop in Canfield, OH.
